

Attention Boxford Residents:

LARGE METAL ITEM PICK-UP DAY

Monday & Tuesday, May 18th & 19th

(Same as your trash pick-up day)

Out at curb by 7:00 am

The Boxford Board of Health has arranged with our trash hauler to pick up your large metal items on the dates above. The date for *your* large metal item pick-up will coincide with your regular trash pick-up day. Be sure to have all item(s) curbside by 7 am. No trash stickers are required. Below is a list of acceptable materials that can be left curbside for pick-up.

If you have a large metal item that you would like to have picked up and it is not listed below, if the item is non-hazardous, at least 80% metal (and broken down if necessary), and doesn't contain freon, it will be picked up. Items that are mostly wood or plastic with some metal will **not** be taken. Items cannot be longer than 6 feet.

Examples of Items Allowed:

- Metal Bike Frames
- Stoves
- Metal Furniture
- Metal Desks
- Broken Down Metal Swing Sets
- Metal Piping (cut down to 4 foot pieces)
- Lawn Mowers (no ride-on mowers; all fluids must be drained and gas tanks removed)
- White Good Items: Stove, Water Heater, Washer, Dryer (no freon items)
- Metal Frames for Lawn Furniture
- Metal Bed Frames
- Grills (no gas canisters allowed)

Examples of Items Not Allowed:

- Refrigerators*
- Air Conditioners*
- Dehumidifiers, etc. still containing freon*
- Items longer than 6 feet
- Items containing less than 80% metal
- Tanks or containers containing hazardous materials
- Chain Link Fences

*Items containing freon will not be accepted due to new DEP regulations and guidelines that our provider has to strictly adhere to. If you would like to leave an item that contains freon and can provide a certificate that the freon has been removed, please call JRM at 800-323-4285 for further instructions. Items that have freon include refrigerators, air conditioners and freezers. Please note: Boxford's Recycling Center open Saturdays from 8 am to 3:30 pm **does** accept refrigerators and air conditioners for a fee.

The next pickup day will be announced in the Fall of 2015.
