DIRECTOR'S REPORT: K. Bourque

- Finances:
 - The Massachusetts Library Commission certified the Municipality of Boxford's eligibility to receive State Aid
 - Approximately \$7,000 will be received by the middle of the month
- Programming:
 - > November
 - Music and Movement 85 participants=pre-pandemic attendance
 - Preschool Storytimes 118 participants= pre-pandemic attendance
- Circulation:
 - o FY 2023 doing well
 - July through November 29,000 items circulated

- December Programming and Outreach
 - Winter Fest and Letters to Santa
 - 130 letters
 - Photos with Santa and Mrs. Claus
 - 60 participants

YOUTH SERVICES STAFF PROPOSAL UPDATE: K. Bourque

- Additional Feedback (Post November Meeting)
 - From conversations with other Town Department Heads, it has become more evident that this year will be a very contentious budget year. The following factors will negatively impact the approval process for the Library's Staffing proposal:
 - Fire Department is looking for additional staff
 - The newly constructed Community Center at 10 Elm Street will be looking for additional staff.
 - The Town Employees union contracts are in the negotiation process and are expected to include substantial increases
 - The Town is renegotiating the trash contract with Waste Management
 - The impact of high inflation on taxpayers
- Given these factors, I am recommending the Trustees hold off on moving the staffing proposal forward until the financial outlook for the Town improves.
 - We will use current staff and time creatively until there is less pressure on town's finances

MOTION: J.P. Ryan made a motion seconded by J. Smallman to postpone the request for a Youth Services Staff position to be placed on the May warrant.
