 - Staff achieved over 18 hours of Professional Development
 - Assessment of Learning Anew led to adjustment of monthly goals.
 - This quarter the training will be in April re Readers' Advisory with lunch

 - Green is now the new standard for service signs vs blue.
- Survey of various Town Hall and Library signs was done and most prevalent two were presented

- Two Recommended Sign Designs discussed for Town Hall/Library sign
 - Sub-committee preferred style was discussed with ball park cost of \$8,342.50
 - Town previously approved sign style included Town seal, Times Roman lettering
