The Boxford Council on Aging is committed to reopening our offices and programs in a way that promotes the health and safety of our residents, staff, volunteers and instructors. This includes the enforcement of "social distancing", the wearing of face masks, access to hand sanitizer and the following of all State Travel Orders. Currently several activities are being held outdoors under a large tent. As circumstances permit, we will increase our outdoor programming.

Please note that we miss all of you and know that many of you are really feeling isolated. While our building remains closed to the public, we are here most days and frequently check our messages. If you need a friendly voice to chat with, do not hesitate to call.

#### Some COA updates while we were away!

**First,** our elevator lift has been replaced, passed inspection and is ready to use.

**Second,** the floor upstairs has been replaced and looks amazing. We can not wait for you all to see it when the building reopens to the public.

**Third,** if you have driven by the COA, you may have seen a big white tent out by the picnic tables. We have started up some outdoor classes and slowly adding more. Classes are listed on page 2.

Registration is a MUST!!

Due to the high interest in classes, we anticipate that classes will fill quickly. If you are seriously interested in a class, we suggest you call the COA as soon as possible. No later than noon on the day before the class. No walk-ins allowed! If you have signed up for a class and you do not show up, you will be responsible for the cost. Please call us by noon on the day before the class to cancel. All equipment used during classes will be sanitized after each use.

Our building is **CLOSED** but the bathrooms will be available with a pass and will be sanitized after each use. **These classes are held rain or shine.** 

Voting!

We have the option of voting in person or by mail. We hope that voting by mail will reduce lines on election day. To request a mail in ballot for the November election you should contact the town clerk @ 978-887-0710 before October 24th. In-person voting for the State Election is November 3rd. Early voting will take place over 14 days (10/17 - 10/30.)


I planted myself on the sofa at the start of mid March and I've grown bigger ever since.
