Minutes, Announcements, and Bills

Minutes: Minutes were reviewed from the January 28, 2018 meeting. **Motion** by **D. Taylor** to accept minutes as amended, seconded by **H. Jeppesen** Approved **unanimously**.

Director's Update

The Boxford Community Store and the West Village Provisions have been in touch with septic engineers to upgrade their septic systems in the near future.

Kathy Benevento the Finance Director sent out an email regarding the cost of the Town's trash stickers. **D. Taylor** stated the warrant closes on April 8 and the cost of the stickers on the warrant is \$2.50 which can not be changed now at the next Annual Town meeting.

Northeast Massachusetts Mosquito Control and Wetlands Management District

William Mehaffey and Kimberly Foss from the NEMMC were present at the meeting to discuss with the Board their operations, surveillance, and mosquito management for 2019. It was explained to the Board in full detail the services they provide the Town throughout the year along with information on their spray products and the process in which they utilize them.

Large Septic System Regulation Discussion

The Board continued their discussion on the Waste Water Treatment Plants. **R. Fahrner** stated his recommendations on edits for the regulation. **D. Taylor** said he wanted to set a time limit to the Board for any input or changes to be sent back to him by the weekend and then a final draft will be sent out next week. The Board members should then review it and reply back only to **D. Taylor**. The next step would be to schedule a hearing on the draft document which would then become a final draft after such hearing. The Board hopes to have this signed made a law by the end of April.

Utility Pole Hearing-Ipswich Rd. and Pond St.

All the poles that are being placed are out of the hundred foot radius from all wells.

D. Taylor motioned that pole placement application shows to be in compliance with the Board's regulation, **seconded** by **H. Jeppesen**. Approved **unanimously**.
