Safety Standards for Playgrounds

The Boxford Board of Health provides the following guidance for the use of playgrounds in Boxford. This guidance is based on Massachusetts guidelines accessible at: https://www.mass.gov/doc/safety-standards-for-playgrounds-spray-decks-and-outdoorfitness-areas/download.

- 1. No Town employees or staff is charged with the cleaning and sanitation of playground areas and equipment. Cleaning and sanitation are the responsibility of playground users.
- 2. Playground users will maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet from each other or wear a face mask. Parents and guardians are required to ensure children maintain proper distancing and/or the wearing of face masks.
- 3. Parents and guardians should provide a cleaning agent (such as Lysol or Chlorox sprays) and wipe down equipment used by their children when leaving the playground. Cleaning aids such as paper towels should be placed in a bag, sealed and taken home to dispose in the trash. High touch surfaces requiring cleaning include surfaces made of plastic or metal such as grab bars, railings, tables, and benches.
- 4. If possible, parents, quardians and children should clean their hands with a hand sanitizer when leaving the playground. Hands should be washed again when arriving home.
- 5. If a visitor to a playground is determined to have COVID-19, the playground will be closed for at least 24 hours by the Board of Health.
- 6. All playground visitors shall observe a 'carry in, carry out' policy with trash.
