- June Statistics

 - That drop was due to reduced access to materials because of no inter-library loans
 - Curbside pick ups being very popular which brought down Overdrive checkouts.

 - Poetry Circle and Small Business Administration each had 10 attendees.
- Finances
 - Library Grant and Gift Fund accounts are back up due to reimbursement from CARES ACT

 - Incentives include Amazon Gift Cards and Scholastic Books for Children

INTERVIEW WITH POTENTIAL LIBRARY TRUSTEE CANDIDATES: K. Bourque

- What are the major issues facing the Boxford Library and how do you think the Library Trustees can be part of the solution?
 - Follow up: How/where would you like to see the Library grow and what would you bring to the table to help that growth process?
- Do you have any questions for the board?

K. Bourque:

- Trustee, Stephen Harvey has submitted his resignation today
- Town Administrator will be contacted tomorrow morning to determine if S. Harvey's position needs to be advertised for two weeks
- Discussion of the six candidates was held (3 from this week and 3 interviewed on June 22)
- Another Special meeting will be called

UPDATE ON TOWN HALL/LIBRARY FACILITY: K. Bourque

- PBC (Permanent Building Committee) member, B. Hazelwood will be the primary presenter of facts for the Warrant regarding the Town Hall/Library Facility at the Annual Town Meeting along with Rich O'Brien.
- The primary goals of the Library project are
 - Utilize the service space in a more efficient and effective manner
 - o Create a more welcoming space through increased light and comfortable seating
 - Reduce confusion about the space by increasing visibility of the Library services.
- Projected increases in space and services as a result of the project:
 - 10% more shelving capacity
 - 100% computer availability
 - 45% increase in comfortable seating to use resources
- The Library Stabilization Fund has increased by \$20,000 over the past 2 years from \$475,000 to \$495,000 which reduces the overall tax impact of the project.

PHASES REOPENING UPDATE: K. Bourque

- The Town's latest projected time for opening Town Buildings is the beginning to mid-September.
- Potential service models were discussed
- MVLC is discussing how the return of transferring materials between libraries will work

OTHER BUSINESS:

- Chair, J.P. Ryan, thanked S. Harvey for his service on the Board of The Boxford Town Library Trustees.
- Vice-Chair, J. Smallman stated that she and J.P. Ryan visited Jeanette Glesmann, retired Chair, and presented her with a gift certificate to Pettengill Farm and a cake in the shape of a book made by J.P. Ryan.
