- Draft articles for the Annual Town Meeting on May 14, 2019, were in the Trustees'
 Packet
- Article 11 requests funds to prepare design plans and specifications and requires a 2/3's vote at Town Meeting.
 - The article provides for using funds from the Historic Preservation Community Preservation Fund balance, the Senior Center Gift Fund, and authorizes the Council on Aging and others to seek private donations, grants, and contributions as well as approval of the Board of Selectmen to borrow funds.
- C. Eckert asked for Trustees support. The Trustees had no objections to the article.

 - Bump out for addition
- Bump Out
 - Request conceptual design
 - Construction costs
 - Request before envelope repair
- Expand within the footprint
 - Reviewed Town Hall Floor 1 and 2 plans K. Bourque presented based on suggestions from Lauren Stara, MBLC Library Building Specialists report and Five Year Long Range Plan.
 - Gain access vs. square feet because of ADA requirements
 - Would limit meeting space for Town Committees
- K. Bourque will discuss with Friends funds for conceptual plans

REPORT OF THE POLICY REVIEW SUBCOMMITTEE: J. Glesmann

- Revision of: Policy on Museum Passes
 - Reviewed M.G.L. c. 78, s.8 interpretation of Commonwealth card holders regarding Museum Passes and amended Policy on Museum Passes.
- E. Mullard made a motion seconded by J. Smallman to accept the Policy on Museum Passes as presented. The vote was unanimous.
 - Suspension of Policy on Bicycles and Strollers
 - According to the Town Administrator, Alan Benson, the current policy is not needed.
 - Any loss on Municipal property is covered under the Town's Liability
