Dear Boxford Conservation Commission Members:

On October 10, 2019 Robert E. Marini of **NativeTEC** identified the following Resource area as wooded swamp. The owner wishes to construct a barn in the rear yards outside the 50' no-build zone. It's oriented as the client wishes and any access to the barn can occur outside the 50' No-Build Area, as demonstrated by a dashed driveway over the existing lawn.

The CONSTRUCTION SEQUENCE shall be as follows:

- Install erosion control barriers (silt sock) to intercept sediment from the work limits, as indicated on the NOI Plan. Pink flags 2-11 were located in the field and are adequate to determine the wetland setbacks on the maintained lawn yard portion of the property where the proposed lawn and circulation lies.
- Clear several existing trees and remove topsoil and gravel as needed to prepare for the slab and footings. Regrade as necessary to accomplish the proposed grades
- Proposed site features include construction of the proposed addition, pool, wall repair, decking and planting.
- Inspect that the barn is completed, and that the lawn is re-established in disturbed areas.

There are no Certified Vernal Pools or Estimated habitat areas within the limits of concern of this site. buffer zone of beach resource projects across the property. We have used the NRCS Web Soil Survey to compile soil identification and note that the site is outside the flood zone on a FEMA Map




USGS LOCUS MAP






