Introduction:

The subject property is identified as Map 24, Block 3, Lot 18 and is otherwise known as 82 Herrick Road. The lot is approximately 2.4 acres in size, and is developed with a single-family dwelling; which according to the Boxford Assessor's database, was constructed in 1973. The property is located to the north west of the intersection of Sheffield Road and Herrick Road and back up to Cedar Pond. A large Bordering Vegetated Wetland (BVW) existing in the rear of the parcel that borders on Cedar Pond.

According to the NRCS Web Soil Survey, the upland soils on the subject lot are mapped as (421C), Canton fine sandy loam, and the wetland portions of the property are mapped as (52A) Freetown muck.

According to the current Division of Fisheries and Wildlife, Natural Heritage and Endangered Species Program (NHESP) Atlas, the property is not mapped as Priority Habit of Rare Species or Estimated Habitats of Rare Wildlife, nor is the property mapped as an Area of Critical Environmental Concern (ACEC).

Proposed Activities:

The applicant is proposing to remove a series of five railroad tie retaining walls that exist in the rear of the dwelling and to replace them with a single gravity block retaining wall that will be approximately 2.5 feet high. The remainder of the back yard is proposed to be graded, loamed and seeded, within the footprint of the existing maintained lawn area.

In addition to the activities listed above, the applicant is proposing to expand the existing paver patio and to install a pizza oven on the rear of the existing dwelling.

Construction access will be off the driveway and following the construction effort the temporary access road will be loamed and seeded. Erosion controls are proposed to be installed along the existing fence to protect the downgradient BVW's during the project. The erosion controls are proposed to remain in place until all areas are stabilized and permission is granted for their removal from the Conservation Commission.

Jurisdictional Wetland Resource Areas:

<u>Bordering Vegetated Wetlands:</u> The Bordering Vegetated Wetlands (BVW) were delineated on the subject property by Greg Hochmuth, PWS, CWS from Williams & Sparages LLC on October 15, 2021, (see attached wetland field data forms).



No BVW is proposed to be altered as a result of this application.
