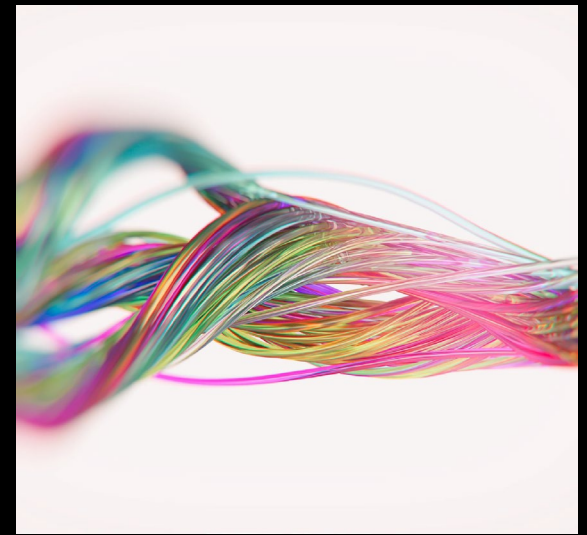

## West Boxford Center

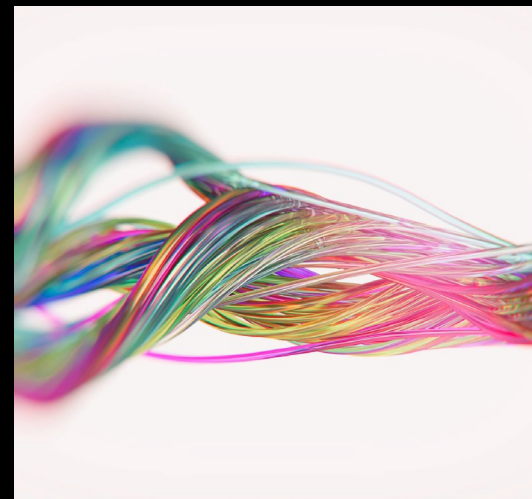
Summer installation in conjunction with Summer Fest

- Bench & Sign post at 10 Elm

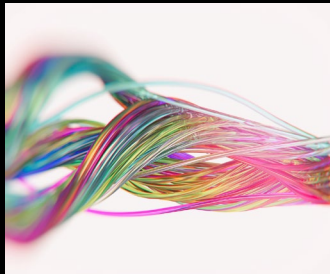


# Community Yarn Art Installation Project
