

| To the Conservation Commission:

| I am requesting a Determination of Negligible Impact for the removal of at least 5 trees and invasive understory vegetation located at 665 Main Street and within 100-feet of a Bordering Vegetated Wetland, in order to "liberate" the overgrown meadow, improve conditions for the bee yard, which now has 5 additional hives, give access to an existing well and restore/improve the general, historical agricultural conditions of the land. We will preserve the 3 elm trees, a healthy young ash and whatever other healthy, viable, non-invasive indigenous vegetation. Any stumps will be grinded (sp?), dumped soil and granite blocks removed, if possible, and any other dump sites, currently invisible, cleaned up. Attached is a schematic plan of the farm.
