To the Conservation Commission, Town of Boxford, Massachusetts.

I request a determination of negligible impact for the removal of 2 trees which are within the 100 foot buffer zone of wetlands on the property at 36 Towne Rd, Boxford.

In storm Riley we had two trees brought down by wind which caused damage to the house.

Subsequently we have had a study performed by Mayer Tree Inc. to determine if there are further trees which are a risk to the property. They identified 6 trees of which 2 are in the 100 foot wetland buffer zone and mentioned in the report (attached).

Another tree beyond the 6 is in the buffer zone and has already been broken and they recommend cutting and leaving that tree so it is safe.

The wetland on the property is a drainage ditch which is an overflow from a vernal pool and ends at Towne Rd opposite no 33.
