Notice of Intent Far Corner Golf Club Bridge Replacement Boxford, MA




Fig. 1 USGS Site Locus

The project site is the Far Corner Golf Club at 5 Barker Street in Boxford. The site contains an approximately 1.7-acre man-made irrigation pond with an elevated 60-foot long golf cart bridge spanning the north to south banks. The project site is indicated in Figure 1 below.

Project Description

The project proposes to replace the existing bridge with a 10-foot longer span to be installed using four 6-inch helical pile footings on each side. The existing concrete footings will be saw-cut to at or just below grade. The bridge can be installed entirely from the upland areas using a crane. Standard erosion controls will be installed on both banks to prevent siltation of the waterway. The work is not expected to generate any significant soil disturbance. However, any vegetated areas that are disturbed during construction will be restored immediately following work.

Wetland Resource Areas

Rimmer Environmental Consulting (REC) conducted a field inspection of the project area on October 19, 2020. At that time, wetland resources subject to jurisdiction under the Massachusetts Wetlands Protection Act (MGL Ch 131 §. 40) were identified. The project is not subject to the Town of Boxford Wetlands Bylaw as the resource is a man-made pond on a golf course which is specifically exempted from jurisdiction.

The following wetland resources were observed and delineated within the project site.

Inland Bank

The shoreline of the irrigation pond contains Inland Bank resource as defined under 310 CMR 10.54. The upper limit of Bank is at the first observable break in slope or mean high water, whichever is lower and was defined by flags 1-5 on the north bank and 8-11 on the south bank. Above the bank is mowed turf. There is no Bordering Vegetated Wetland extending from the Bank. There is a 100-foot Buffer Zone extending from the upper limit of Bank resource.

Other Resources

The project area is not within Estimated Habitat of Rare Wetlands Wildlife or Priority Habitat and does not contain certified vernal pools as determined by the most currently available information on MassGIS provided by the Mass. Division of Fisheries and Wildlife – Natural Heritage and Endangered Species Program.
