Historical Property Tax Increases

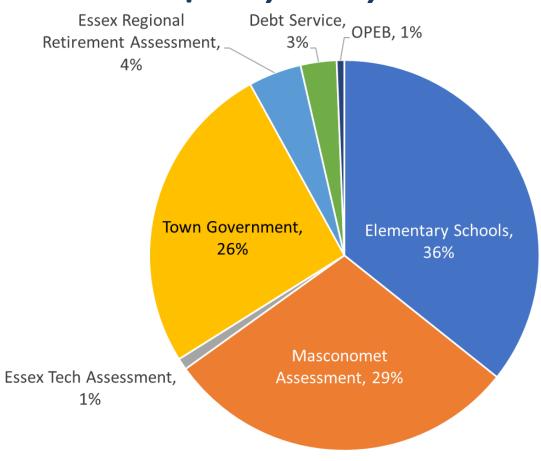

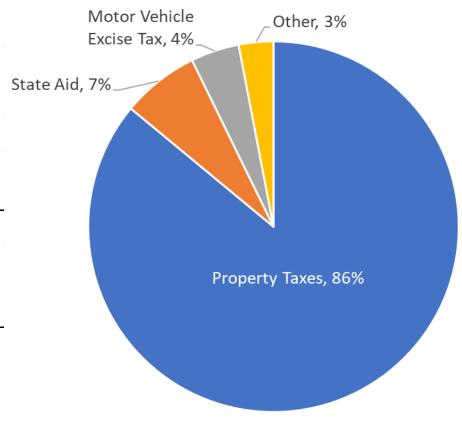

FY25 and Beyond



- The Town will continue to follow strong financial management policies (shout out)
 - Strong management and good financial policies and practices have allowed Boxford to maintain its "AAA" bond rating from S&P Global
- "New Growth" revenue from The Willows at Boxford will begin to be realized in FY25 and FY26
- Future budgets may face stress from increases in debt service spending:
 - Elementary School Site Improvements
 - DPW Garage
 - Masconomet Capital Plan including potential new turf fields and stadium
- Expiration of federal COVID-19 relief grants from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA)
