

## Standard Conditions for: NG-071320-23

The approval of the Town of Boxford is conditioned on the following:

- 1. A traffic management plan shall be submitted and approved by the town prior to work commencing.
- 2. All work under this permit shall be done in conformance with the Massachusetts Highway Department Standard Specifications for Highways and Bridges dated 1988, the Supplemental Specifications dated June 15, 2012, and the Interim Supplemental Specifications; the 2012 Construction Standard Details, the 1990 Standard Drawings for Signs and Supports; the 2009 Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) with Massachusetts Amendments and the Standard Municipal Traffic Code. More specifically, the backfill material shall meet the specifications of for:
  - a. Sand, M1.04.0
  - b. Gravel or Processed Gravel, M1.03.0, M1.03.1
- 3. The contractor shall install a permanent patch to the satisfaction of the inspector. Backfill material shall conform to the aforementioned specifications and shall be compacted in 6" lifts to a 95% Compaction. The overall pavement thickness shall match the existing pavement thickness or shall be a minimum of 2" Binder Course and 2" Top course, whichever is greater. In the event the pavement thickness is greater than 4", Binder Course shall be brought to within 2" of existing grade to ensure adequate top wearing course thickness is achieved.
- 4. The pavement shall be saw cut at the predetermined work limits. The contractor will tack the exposed asphalt faces at the saw cuts prior to paving.
- 5. Public shade tree(s) shall be double wrapped in a protective barrier (i.e 2x4, snow fence) in such a manner that it remains protected from damage for the duration of the work.

- 6. Any Catch Basins within 50' downstream of the limit of excavation shall have erosion control devices installed to prevent negative downstream impacts and/or the deposit of material within the town's drainage network.
- 7. Town of Boxford Street Opening Permits require the contractor to hire not only a Police Detail Officer, but also, a DPW Highway employee for all work hours when work is being performed in the Town's right-of-way, to inspect work performed. The charge for the DPW employee is the same as the Detail Officer per hour and will be scheduled a minimum of **48 hours** in advance with the DPW.
