Re: Notice of Intent Application – 76 Surrey Lane

Owner & Applicant: David Wheeler

Dear Commission Members:

Please find enclosed a Notice of Intent (NOI) application for the above referenced property. The proposed project involves work in a bordering vegetated wetland and within the 100 foot buffer zone to bordering vegetated wetlands. Wetland resource areas were delineated by DeRosa Environmental Consulting, Inc. Proposed work within the wetlands include minor grading to correct drainage flow patterns that appear to have been impacted years ago when unauthorized activities were performed on the site. An Enforcement Order was issued by the Boxford Conservation Commission in Nov. 2004 for this activity which is discussed later. Other work within the wetland includes enhancement plantings and the removal of an existing post and rail fence. Work within the 100 foot wetland buffer zone includes the creation of approximately 2,050 sf of wetlands to restore the hydrologic connection between the A Series and L Series wetlands on site. Other work within the 100 foot buffer zone includes enhancement plantings, grading to correct drainage issues, abandonment of an existing gravel drive, construction of a new gravel drive and the installation of a fence.

Most of the work proposed is located north east of the existing dwelling. In Nov. 2004 the Boxford Conservation Commission issued an Enforcement Order for unauthorized work on this property that created a swimming pond, beach and water feature (i.e.: stone waterfall structure). At that time a shed was also constructed that housed the pumps and filters for the water feature and the pond. A restoration plan was prepared, approved and implemented. It is our understanding that all the requirements of the restoration plan, including monitoring of the plantings, was completed and signed off by the Town. Prior to Mr. Wheeler purchasing the property, in September 2017, a large portion of the swimming pond was filled in and converted to lawn. Mr. Wheeler noticed that the lawn upslope of the small pond did not drain well and appeared uneven. We visited the site and after some research it was apparent that a large portion of the previous pond was filled in and that was the area that was uneven and not draining. Grading is required/proposed to provide a positive pitch so that the yard will drain properly. While examining the site it appeared that work associated with the creation of the swimming pond may have created a disconnect between the A Series and L Series wetlands shown on the plan. Further evaluation of the wetland areas revealed that flow within the L Series wetland was most likely impacted when the swimming pond was built. The proposed project involves the creation

of approximately 2,050 sf of wetland to hydrologically connect the A Series and L Series wetlands. Grading within the L Series wetland is required to achieve the hydrologic connection so there is approximately 1,050 sf of temporary alteration within the L Series wetland proposed. The wetland creation, wetland enhancement plantings and buffer zone enhancement plantings proposed are all discussed/shown in the Proposed Wetland Restoration Plan/Report prepared by DeRosa Environmental Consulting, Inc., dated July 15, 2019, included with the NOI application.

Other work proposed within the buffer zone is the abandonment of an existing gravel drive and the construction of a new gravel drive further from the wetland than the existing abandoned drive. This proposed gravel drive will connect to an existing wood road. Other work proposed in the buffer zone includes the installation of a fence in the buffer zone. The fence is needed to provide a safe space for Mr. Wheeler's family and pets as they are experiencing issues with coyotes and fisher cats.
