Re: 317 Middleton Road Enforcement Order and After-the-Fact Notice of Intent

Dear Members of the Commission,

In response to the Enforcement Order issued by the Town of Boxford Conservation Commission, Hancock Associates has been hired by Mr. Andrew Colllamore for work on the property located at 317 Middleton Road. The Enforcement Order was issued in response to grading and removal of vegetation within the 100-foot Buffer Zone to Bordering Vegetated Wetlands. Following the Conservation Commission meeting on 19 June 2018, the Commission required the Applicant to submit an after-the-fact Notice of Intent for the work described above.

A Hancock Associates Wetland Scientist delineated the Bordering Vegetated Wetlands (BVW) on 30 May 2018. The BVW is marked with blue flagging tape numbered A-1 through A-17. The BVW is dominated by sensitive fern (Onoclea sensibilis - FACW), cinnamon fern (Osmundastrum cinnamomeum - FACW), red maple (Acer rubrum - FAC), skunk cabbage (Symplocarpus foetidus - OBL), sweet pepperbush (Clethra alnifolia - FAC), sedges (Carex spp. - FACW), and poison ivy (Toxicodendron radicans - FAC). The uplands are dominated by white pine (Pinus strobus - FACU), hay-scented fern (Dennstaedtia punctilobula - UPL), and upland grasses.

The Enforcement Order was issued after the homeowner began to clear areas along the wetland edge. The area of clearing consisted of overgrown shrubs and two trees. The homeowner installed a siltation barrier in the form of a silt fence and seeded the disturbed area with a native conservation seed mixture.

The conservation seed mixture has grown in well and is stable. The disturbed area is 100% vegetated. Native ferns and herbaceous cover has begun to regrow within the cleared area as well. As requested in the 19 June 2018 meeting, the silt fence has been removed in response to the growth and coverage of the seed mixture.

As shown on the plan, there is a raised garden and a play structure located in and partially within the 25' No-Disturbance Zone. These structures are to be relocated outside of the 25' No-Disturbance Zone. The Applicant proposes two sheds and an animal pen outside of the 25' No-Disturbance Zone within existing lawn areas.

A note has been added to the plan to state that there shall be no mowing within the 25' No-Disturbance Zone and the Applicant will be installing "No-Disturbance Zone Markers" along the 25' line.
