

RE: Resident Trash and Recycling Survey Results


As you will recall, in August, the Waste Stream Task Force (WSTF) finalized an eight-question resident survey to learn more about resident trash and recycling habits under the current manual collection system, as well as to gather input from residents regarding the structure of a future automated collection system. The survey was made available during the month of September; it could be completed electronically through the Town website and via hard copy at Town buildings. To increase resident awareness of the survey, a postcard mailer was sent to all 2,800 households in Boxford. In total, the Town received **983 responses**, 972 of which were submitted through the online survey and **11** of which were submitted via hard copy survey.

Below are the results of the survey:


1. How many trash (not recycling) barrels do you currently put out each week?




- 2. Approximately what size (in gallons) are the trash barrels that you currently use?
- The average response was 42 gallons
- The median response was **35 gallons**
- 3. Approximately what size (in gallons) are the recycling barrels/containers that you currently use?
- The average response was 37 gallons
- The median response was 32 gallons
- 4. If the Town were to issue standard trash containers, to be picked up weekly, would your household prefer a 32-gallon or 64-gallon container?



5. If the Town were to issue standard recycling containers, to be picked up weekly, would your household prefer a 32-gallon or 64-gallon container?




6. Would your household need multiple trash (not recycling) containers?



7. If you answered "yes" to the question above, how many additional trash (not recycling) containers do you estimate that your household will need?

423 respondents answered "yes" to the above question (question #6).



8. If it resulted in savings to the Town and the taxpayers, would you want to recycle on a biweekly (every other week) basis? In this scenario, the larger (64-gallon) containers would be issued for recycling.
